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IB Mission Statement

The International Baccalaureate aims to develop inquiring, knowledgeable and caring young people who help to create a better and more peaceful world through intercultural understanding and respect.

To this end the organization works with schools, governments and international organizations to develop challenging programmes of international education and rigorous assessment.

These programmes encourage students across the world to become active, compassionate and lifelong learners who understand that other people, with their differences, can also be right.

IB Learner Profile

The aim of all IB programmes is to develop internationally minded people who, recognizing their common humanity and shared guardianship of the planet, help to create a better and more peaceful world.

IB learners strive to be **inquirers, knowledgeable, thinkers, communicators, principled, open-minded, caring, risk-takers, balanced, reflective.**

Students applying to the IB DP in Slovenia undergo selection processes. There are currently 22 places offered each year for students whose nationality is Slovene and 9 additional places for students who come from the Former Yugoslav Republics (Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Montenegro, FYR Macedonia and Serbia).

1. Admissions - General Criteria

Applicants for the IB DP in Slovenia are selected according to the following general criteria which are true for all three IB DP schools in Slovenia.

General criteria:

- Are 16 or 17 years of age,
- Have during the current school year completed second year of High school (4 year programme) with at least 'very good' final grades,
- Have achieved at least grade 'very good' (4) final grade at the following subjects: mother tongue (Slovene, Italian or Hungarian), Mathematics, English,
- Active participation in cultural and sports activities, taking part at national competitions (or Olympics).

2. Admissions Decisions and Student Placement at II. gimnazija Maribor

Admissions decisions are made by the II. gimnazija Maribor Admissions Committee, which is composed of the Head of school, IB DP Coordinator and a Teacher teaching within the IB DP Programme. This committee is responsible for interviewing, selecting and admitting the future IB students.

The following criteria should be applied for admission to II. gimnazija Maribor:

1. Academic Achievement (50%)
2. Extra – curricular activities (10%)
3. Competitions (10%)
4. Teacher references (10%)
5. Interview (20%)

3. Admissions Process

A decision to admit a student to II. gimnazija Maribor is based on the fulfilment of the admission requirements, space availability, and the student's ability to fulfil the programme's requirements. Students can only apply to IB DP year 11.

New students are admitted every year in May, provided that the applicants have completed the application process.

a.) Admissions Documentation

This is provided by the IB DP Coordinator and is posted on our webpage (mm-druga.si/vpis). Students should apply by the end of March every year. The interviews are held in April.

b.) Admissions Decisions

The Application status or decision should be notified to students in May.

c.) Waiting List

A qualified applicant is placed on a waiting list when there is no space available. The student's position is clarified, namely 1st, 2nd or 3rd candidate on the waiting list.

d.) Denial

Students may be denied admission if they had not met the admissions criteria.

e.) Official Admissions Package

Students admitted to the IB DP programme should receive an official admissions package at the students', parents' and teachers' meeting in June. The admissions package should contain further information on day-to-day school life (schedule, choice of subjects, list of teachers, list of course books, etc.) and several forms that need to be completed. It should also include some basic policies (assessment and evaluation) and procedures.

f.) Students should confirm admission on the last day of school, 24. 6., when they should submit the signed papers.

I. SPLOŠNI POGOJI ZA VPIS šolsko leto 2014/16

Program intenzivno pripravlja dijake na opravljanje mednarodne mature (International Baccalaureate). Uspešno opravljena mednarodna matura omogoča vpis na več kot 2.500 univerz po svetu.

Pogoji za vpis:

- starost predvidoma 16 do 17 let;
- v šolskem letu 2013/2014 končan drugi letnik srednje šole (štiriletni program) z najmanj prav dobrim splošnim učnim uspehom;
- najmanj prav dober učni uspeh iz predmetov slovenščina ali italijanščina ali madžarščina kot materni jezik, angleščina in matematika;
- aktivno vključevanje v dejavnosti na področju kulture in športa ter udeležba na različnih tekmovanjih (državnih in mednarodnih tekmovanjih ter olimpijadah) iz znanja matematike, jezikov, naravoslovja, računalništva in podobno.

K vlogi morajo priložiti fotokopijo spričevala prvega letnika in obvestila o uspehu v drugem letniku, dokazila o udeleževanju in uspehu na področju obšolskih dejavnosti in dokazila o dosežkih na tekmovanjih. Nepopolne prijave in prijave, ki bodo prispele po za to določenem roku, ne bodo upoštevane.
