PEAK: new undergraduate program

- Two undergraduate courses launched in 2012
 - International Program on Environmental Sciences
 - International Program on Japan in East Asia
- 4 year courses resulting in a BA degree All courses taught in English
- Students will study at the Komaba campus at the heart of Tokyo - near Shibuya, Harajuku
- No knowledge in Japanese required
 - Japanese language classes are included in the course

Fees

- Application fee: JPY 5,000 (around €34)
- Admission fee: JPY 282,000 (around €2,000)(paid upon enrollment)
- Annual tuition fee: JPY 535,800 (around €3,700)
- * These are subject to change.
- * All students are charged the same fees regardless of their nationalities or citizenships.

Estimated monthly living expenses

- Accommodation:

 - * All PEAK students have the option of living in the International Lodge for their 2 years.
 - @ Private housing JPY 70,000 (around €490)
- Others (food, books, etc.) JPY 60,000 (around €410)
- Total monthly expenses:
 JPY 100,000 130,000 (around €690-€900)



The University of Tokyo Scholarships

Provides enrollment fee, tuition fees, a place in the student lodge and monthly living expenses (JPY120,000, approx.EUR860) for four years.


