

WHEN TO APPLY? IS IT ALREADY LATE?

• Italian universities usually have three application deadlines.

• The first deadline is usually in January, while the last one is usually in March or Mid-April.

• It is not too late, you still have time!



DOCUMENTATION AND REGIONAL SCHOLARSHIP



- You apply through the University portal which contains clear instructions.
- Transcripts, IB predicted grades, SAT (optional)/Admission test, Passport,
 Essays/Motivational Letter, CV, interview.
- If you need help with your application process, there are agencies that help students (Via Academica based in Serbia, helps students from ex Yu).
- Benefits of applying through the agency: free application (for partner universities), free consultation, professional orientation).

REGIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

- Offered by a region in which the University is located.
- You can apply for it after you are admitted to the University.
- Application deadline: August or September.
- A lot of documentation needed, start collecting on time.
- Regional scholarship covers tuition for all students who fit parameters.
- You can also get a certain annual amount of money (also depends on the parameters).



Italian Universities

- Maximum grade at the university level is 30, you pass if you get 18.
- Partial term exams.
- Rejection of your grade.
- General exams.
- Recommendation: LUISS (Political sciences, Computer Science, Economics and Business), Cattolica (Psychology, Economics and Management, Medicine), Bocconi (Political sciences, Economics), Ca'Foscari (Political sciences, Economics), Padua University (Psychology, Information Engineering, Medicine), Politecnico di Torino (Architecture, Biomedical Engineering), University of Pavia, University of Milan Bicocca, University of Milan / Universita Degli Studi di Milano...







General description of the course and entry requirements:

- An inter university degree course between the University of Milan, University of Milan Bicocca and the University of Pavia
- The course is taught entirely in English
- Admission upon passing the admission test (Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Logic and English)
- SAT.

Fees and Funding

- Tuition fee is around 5000, 00€E per year.
- There are both full and partial scholarships available.
- In order to be eligible for scholarship you need to obtain a score of no less than 80/100 on your final high-school exam (IB conversion), no less than 90/100 on your entrance exam and to maintain a grade point average of at least 27/30 throughout the duration of your studies.

Deadlines and Requirements

To get accepted you need to either do an SAT or the TIL entrance exam which can be done online.

I would recommend the entrance exam as that gives you a chance to get the PoliTO scholarship if you get a very good score.

You can do the exam as early as May and as late as July.

You also need a TOEFL or similar English proficiency test, unless you are an IB student in which case the IB diploma is enough with a confirmation that all of your lessons have been held in English.

IB recognition of the diploma. The official IB diploma and the declaration of value.

Stuff you should know

- Accommodation hard to find
- You should start looking for an apartment as soon as possible, or look at the dorms.
- Regional scholarship administered by Edisu Piemonte
- The scholarship requirements come out mid July on the website https://www.edisu.piemonte.it/, should start collecting documents as it does, it takes a long time
- Get your declaration of value (dichiarazione di Valore) as soon as possible as you need it to enroll and to get a study Visa if you are extra EU
